THINK WOOD!

- Funding is available to complete initial woody biomass utilization feasibility studies
- Up to 50% cost-share available to interested facilities

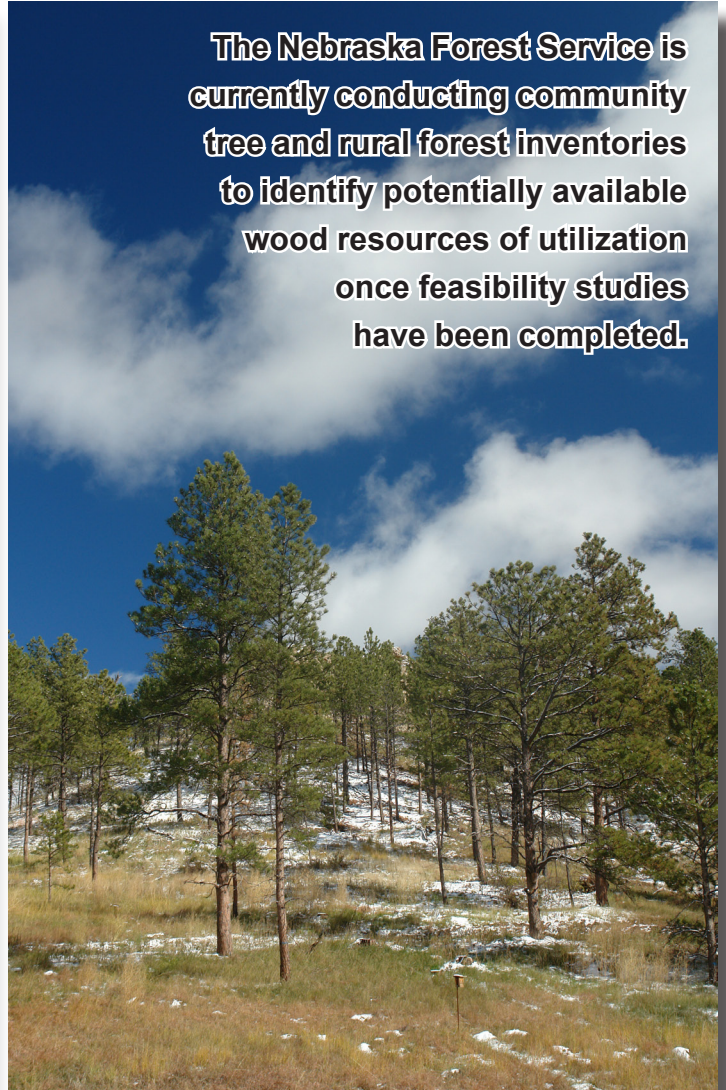
- Targeted facilities include agricultural and livestock operations, warehouses, greenhouse operations, municipal buildings, hospitals, college/school campuses, correctional institutions, pellet manufacturers and alfalfa dehydration plants, among others

- Forest resources in areas such as the Pine Ridge, Niobrara River valley, Missouri River region, Platte River corridor, Loess Canyons, and southwest and southeast Nebraska provide an abundance of unrealized woody biomass potential for facilities in those regions

- Nebraska also has wood fuel manufacturing operations creating wood pellets for small-scale heating scenarios

- Nebraska is home to many potential woody biomass fuel suppliers who are interested in supplying fuel to facilities

The Nebraska Forest Service is currently conducting community tree and rural forest inventories to identify potentially available wood resources of utilization once feasibility studies have been completed.
