### Forest Health presents: Trees and the Four Seasons

Abiotic effects on trees through the seasons:

SPRING—How does a wet or dry spring affect trees? Problems from too much water. How do trees respond to damage from late spring freezes and blizzards?

SUMMER—Heat stroke in trees.

FALL—Leaf drop. Fall watering. Effects of early hard freezes on trees.



WINTER—How trees react to wide temperature shifts. Can they come out of dormancy too soon? Ways to prevent this? Sun scald. Overwintering of insects.

- ☛ Selecting trees for broader purposes
